

Wood Requirements

Wood B Creations – Burt Fleming – 225.953.3721

SIZE

Diameter:

Approximately 14-20 inches. A variety is favorable.

Length:

Approximately 14-16 feet of length is needed per day.

Note:

Leaving wood in longer lengths reduces waste.

TYPE

Cypress
White Pine
Yellow Pine
Catalpa
Sassafras
Butternut
Basswood
Sweet Gum
Poplar
Red Cedar
Black Walnut
Cherry

QUALITY

Wood must be “Fresh Cut”, meaning cut live less than one month prior to carving.

Unacceptable woods are extremely hard woods, dry woods, rotted wood or wood containing metal.

Logs need not be all straight. Flared butt logs, Y-Sections and crotches are useful for carving designs. Bark should be free of mud, dirt and rocks.

Bark should be removed if obtaining wood from a saw mill. Your wood helps to determine the quality of your show and the resulting auction pieces.
